


Figurative Map of the marches from one of the French Army in the Russian campaign 1812 - 1813.

The numbers of men present are represented by the width of the colored zones at a rate of one million for every two thousand men. They are further written upon the zones. The red designates the men who enter into Moscow, the black those who leave it. — The information which has served to draw up the map has been collected from the works of M. A. Chicherin, of Seznac, of Chambres and the excellent map of Barth, the planimetry of the Army from October 1812. In order to better judge until the year the situation of the army, I have assumed that the troops of Cossack Guards out of Marshal Oudinot, who had been pitched at Tchernigov, Krylof and Lutsk, joined around Oulou and Vitebsk, but always numbered with the army.




Successful Startups Co-Founded by Designers Are Not Uncommon

21%

of the so-called global "unicorn" startups across all sectors have co-founders who have embraced design or come from a design, arts, or human-centered background including architecture, design, music, visualization, fine arts, media arts.



via CB Insights, "Since January 1 2013 to February 29, 2016, in the U.S. Internet-Only category top 25 recently funded VC-backed companies."

Last year **20%** (5 out of 25) of the top venture-backed startups had designer co-founders. We check one year later and that number moves to **36%** (9 out of 25).








Schéma Directeur d'un réseau métropolitain

PRINCIPES DE CONCEPTION

Forme et configuration

- Concevoir une forme ergonomique, adaptée à toutes les morphologies, qui permet de reposer l'ensemble du corps (jambes et dos) et de se relever facilement.
- Délimiter chaque place par des éléments contribuant au confort et à la sensation d'intimité.
- Proposer une configuration flexible qui laisse le choix aux utilisateurs (s'isoler ou rester proche de son voisin, poser des affaires personnelles à côté de soi, etc.).

Du parvis jusqu'aux quais, les services sont présents dans l'ensemble des espaces de la gare et organisés selon les contextes et les parcours des voyageurs. La disponibilité des voyageurs, les correspondances, les temps d'attente, le lien avec la ville ne sont pas les mêmes dans une gare de métro, une gare TGV ou un aéroport. Pour répondre aux caractéristiques propres aux gares du Grand Paris, les services proposés relèvent à la fois de la sphère du transport (la gare, lieu de mobilité), de la sphère de la ville (la gare, lieu de centralité) et de la sphère du commerce (la gare, lieu d'activités).

À l'ère du numérique et de la révolution mobile, l'enjeu est d'offrir des services diversifiés et innovants, adaptés non seulement aux attentes des voyageurs mais aussi aux besoins des territoires desservis.



